	<b>RefWorks</b>	<b>EndNote X</b>
<b>Where can I use it?</b>	Any place with Web access	On computers with EndNote installed.
<b>Where are my files stored?</b>	Remotely, on the Web. (Local backups may be made as well.)	Locally, on your computer.
<b>Cost</b>	Free to faculty, students, and staff of UCI.	\$199 (Windows) – current discounted price for UCI students, faculty, staff
<b>Updates?</b>	None necessary (automatic)	Must purchase / install
<b>What happens when I leave?</b>	Export data to other programs (Excel, EndNote, Word, etc.) Or, purchase a subscription.	EndNote is yours and goes with you. New versions (updates) must be purchased, however.
<b>Ease of use</b>	Easy	Moderate
<b>End-user support</b>	Excellent online tutorial. “Help” from menu has a good table of contents (searchable). “Help” also links to email help..
